

The *Can It!* book is one of the Start-to-Finish Literacy books available from Don Johnston (<http://www.donjohnston.com/>). Each set includes three different books linked to an age-appropriate book. *Can It!* is part of a series on “Recycling – Cash in the Trash.”

This collection of photos shows how each page of the book was adapted to include line drawings made from Mayer-Johnson’s Picture Communication Symbols using Boardmaker.

In addition to having each line drawing on the page, we recommend having additional copies of the line drawing symbols for the students to use to communicate their responses to comprehension questions.

The symbols can also be used in the visual mapping or cloze procedures for addressing comprehension before, during, and after reading.
