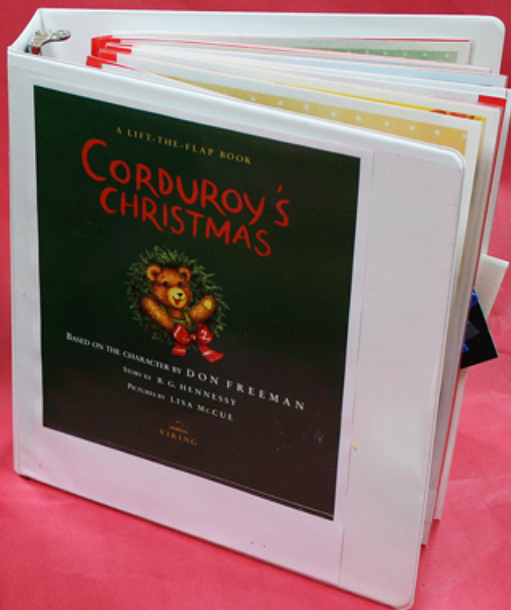


Corduroy's Christmas was adapted using object cues. These symbols serve as concrete cues that can enhance comprehension and can be used to aid the student in answering comprehension questions –before, during, and after reading strategies. The first photo shows a bear used to cue this particular story, a holiday gift bag to be used as the story bag and hold all of the symbols, and a BIGMack voice output device for the student to “read” a repeating line within the story. Correctly activating the BIGMack at the right time demonstrates comprehension during the story. Note that a representative symbol is on the BIGmack to cue the student which message is recorded and will be played when activated.

Corduroy Bear loves Christmas. There are so many things to do.



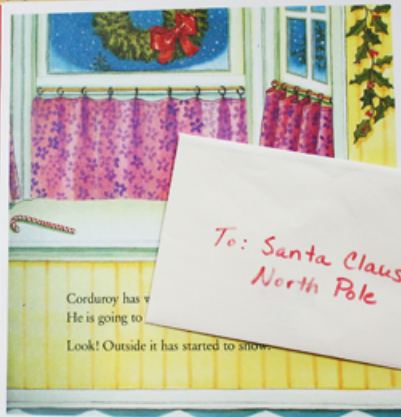
Now it's time to wrap the presents.

Corduroy Bear is writing a letter to Santa. He is going to send it to the North Pole.

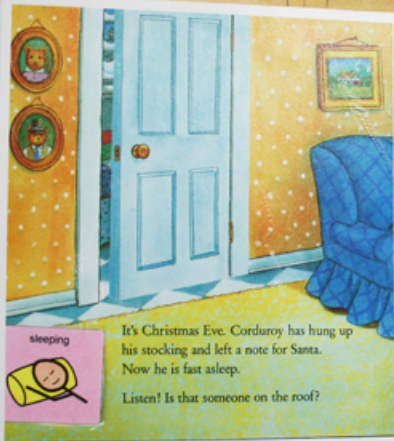


Corduroy Bear loves Christmas. There are so many things to do.

Corduroy Bear is singing Christmas carols. Fa la la la la.

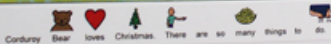

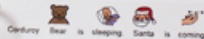


It's Christmas Eve. Corduroy has hung up his stocking and left a note for Santa. Now he is fast asleep.
